



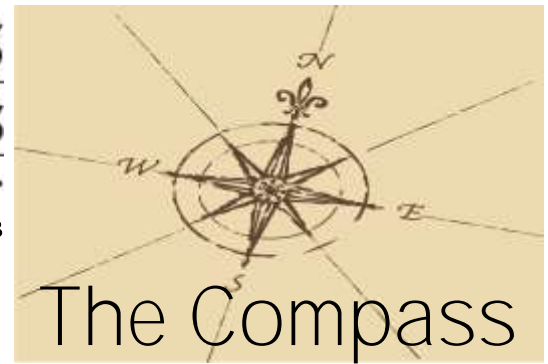

April 12 at the 8:00 St. Mary's mass, Ontario State Deputy Kevin Daudlin presented St. Mary's parish with an icon of our Lay of the Immaculate Conception. A plaque will be installed dedicating it to the memory of Grand Knight Sean McLoughlin. The icon was blessed by Pope Francis and traveled through parishes in Ontario as part of the 2014/2015 Marian Prayer Program before being presented to St. Mary's.



It is a copy of the original painting housed in the Cathedral Basilica Notre-Dame de Quebec. The church and the Archdiocese of Quebec celebrated their 350th anniversary in 2014, the anniversary of the creation of the first parish in Canada. This parish was founded by Bishop Francois Laval under the patronage of Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception nearly two hundred years before the Dogma was officially declared by the Church. In so doing, Bishop Laval honoured the vow of the Jesuits who had preceded him to New France, made on 8th December 1635, to build a church to honour God under the patronage of the Immaculate Conception.

The following is a brief description of the positions requiring candidates to be nominated:

Chancellor: assists the grand knight and the deputy grand knight in the execution of their duties and oversees the council in both their absences. He is charged with strengthening the member's interests in council activities. The chancellor is chairman of the admission committee and a member of the Columbian Squires circle ceremonial team.

Recorder: is responsible for maintaining a true record of all actions of the council and its correspondence.

Treasurer: is responsible for the safekeeping and maintaining of records of all council funds and accounts. He is responsible for depositing money into the council's accounts and provide a certificate of such monies to the grand knight. He is also responsible for payment of all expenses.

Outside Guard: tends to the outer door admitting visitors and members to the inner door.

Inside Guard: checks to make their membership cards are current at the inner door.
